Renowned for its professionalism, Ski Astons boasts an experienced team who work hard to maintain its established reputation of personal service and attention to detail.

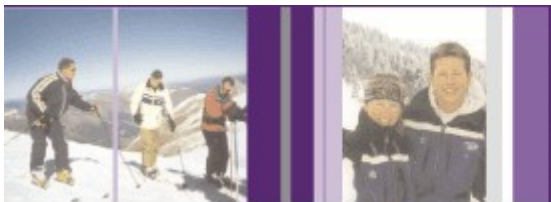

Ski Astons operates mainly in school holiday periods and offers occasional weeks throughout the season. Many of our tutor/guides are in full time employment or education and generally join us during their annual leave.

Please note that our trainee system is available to those who wish to enhance existing skills to reach the required standard.

With limited placements for Christmas, New Year and early Easter tours, priority will be given to those individuals committing to peak weeks (February / Easter).

Ski & Snowboard Tutor/Guide Vacancies

Our tutor/guides are professionals in their field. They have good communication and motivational skills, and enjoy working with children.

Qualifying Criteria:

- Possess current snowbased ski leader /instructor qualification (minimum BASI 2 or equivalent)
- Possess current first aid certificate
- Available for the February half term week / Easter
- Must be willing to join the evening entertainment programme in a motivational capacity
- Should be enthusiastic and enjoy introducing snowsports to children (10 to 18 years)

Typical Ski Day :

- 07:30 Breakfast
- 08:30 Depart Hotel
- 09:00 Take responsibility for designated group
- 11:30 Lunch Break—free time
- 12:30 Resume responsibility for ski group
- 15:30 Return to coach park
- 17:00 Ski tutor/guide debrief
- 18:30 Evening Meal
- 20:00 Evening Entertainment commences

Our tours generally include 6 days skiing, some of which include a half day sightseeing excursion. This is allocated as free time for ski tutor/guides.

Tutor guides will also be required to assess skiers for the UK Snowsport Awards. Pre-written certificates are awarded during the invitational ski ball at the end of the week.



Remuneration

All tutor/guides are provided with the following

- Transport (from designated pick up point)
- Full board accommodation in resort
- Lift pass
- Winter sports insurance and 3rd party liability
- Tutor guide expenses (£200 to £250) (Calculated in Euros at the current rate)
- Free technical clothing with some tours

All tutor/guides also have the opportunity to take advantage of our subsidised training courses and holidays. Please see our course calendar for more details

Astons Uniform

All ski tutor guides involved with school ski tours will be loaned the following:
